WELCOME AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Please stand as you are able.*

***GREETING:** L: The Lord be with you! C: **And also with you!**

*** CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: We come to worship you, O God, the One who created us.

C: You have been with us since the beginning. You have heard our borning cry.

L: We come to worship you, O God, who has been with us throughout every part of our life.

C: You were present at our moment of baptism, and you have watched our lives unfold.

L: We come to worship you, O God, who proclaimed Jesus as your beloved son.

C: You sent the Holy Spirit to lead and guide him. In baptism, you promise the gift of your Spirit to us.

L: We come to praise you, O God, and to find strength for living in the covenant of our baptism.

C: We are confident in your presence beside us and your Spirit to guide us. Amen!

***PRAYERS OF CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS:**

C: We confess that we have sinned and fallen short of the life you have given us. We have not nurtured and cared for the world the way you have called us to. We continue to forget the responsibilities we were entrusted with in our baptism. Forgive us our failings, and lead us back to your waters that refresh us with new life.

(Silent reflection)

L: Hear the voice from heaven: "You are my own, my beloved." You belong to Christ, and through the power of the cross your sins are forgiven. God is faithful and will strengthen you, Christ is gracious and will show you the way, and the power of the Holy Spirit will sustain you, now and forever.

C: We have been freed and raised up to new life in Jesus Christ. Thanks be to God!
