Gather Together

Talk about a time when you needed help and someone stopped what they were doing to help you. How about a time when you went “out of your way” to help someone else? How did that feel? Color the picture of this story together (on the next page) and talk about why each person acted the way they did:

The Priest was in a hurry

The Levite didn’t want to get his hands dirty

The Samaritan saw the need of the hurt man and stopped to help, even setting up help for the days of healing ahead.

Imagine: God hopes that we will notice when someone needs our help and do everything that we can to show God’s love to our neighbor. Can you imagine how different our world would be if everyone noticed someone who was struggling and reached out to lend a hand? Even something so small as offering to baby sit for a mom who needs an hour for herself? Or weeding a neighbor’s garden while they are away? The love that the Samaritan showed is the same love that God wills us with everyday!

Sing Together: Find “Jesu, Jesu” at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZjFNpoEy8mY> and learn the refrain: “Jesu, Jesu, fill us with your love, show us how to serve, the neighbor we have in you.”

Pray Together: God’s coming kingdom is filled with love — love that cares for all people, no matter what social dividers we might construct to separate us. Pray the refrain of “Jesu, Jesu” as a prayer:

Jesu, Jesu, fill us with your love, show us how to serve, the neighbor we have in you. Amen.

Bless One Another: Trace the cross on each other’s forehead and say, “(Name), child of God, be filled with the love of Jesus! Response: **Amen.**”
