## Gather Together:

**Imagine** telling friends about Jesus. How do you think the seeds of God’s love will take root? When we share the love of God in what we say to others and do for them, it is God working through us to shower them with what they need to grow in love and faith

**Bless One Another:** Place you hand on one another’s head and say, “\_\_\_\_\_, you are a child of God, sown with the seeds of God’s love.” Response: “**Amen.**”

**Family project:** Buy some seed packets at the store. Write some little notes that say things like: “God Loves You.”, “Peace”, “Have Faith.” “You are a Child of God.” Make up some of your own. Staple these short notes to the seed packets. Give them to people. Some may fall on “good soil” and bring God’s love to someone.
